The child-to-staff ratio was respected during the inspection.</p> <p>The following items were verified:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Daily activities - Daily routine - Indoor play area and equipment - Child records - Signed consent in the children's records - Incident records - Child guidance <p>The Quality Assurance Monitor had a discussion with the staff responsible regarding designation requirements. It was confirmed that the Quality Improvement plan is in the works and confirmed that the 10 hours of professional learning for this renewal year was completed.</p> <p>The Quality Assurance Monitor observed the children playing in the outdoor play area while other classrooms were transitioning to the outdoor play area. The Quality Assurance monitor also observed the children completing a painting activity. The children were also observed transitioning for lunch time (lunch boxes) and nap time. Positive interactions were observed between the educators and the children.</p> |
