Comments: During the inspection, the QAM noted that a fire drill was not completed for the month of May. Emergency evacuation drills must be done every month. The QAM advised the administrator that two fire drills will need to be completed in June to make up for the missed one. A photo of the record showing both evacuation drill can be sent to the QAM as proof.

Comments: During the inspection, the QAM noted that the review and maintenance plans for all outdoor stationary equipment were not completed for the months of April and May. A review and maintenance plan must be completed monthly for all stationary equipment and should include the review and repair dates, any actions required and taken, and the name of the staff member completing the review. The administrator may send the next completed review, which is expected soon, to the QAM by email to come back into compliance			

<p>General Comments</p> <p>The Quality Assurance Monitor (QAM) conducted an on-site monitoring inspection. During the visit, the following elements were reviewed and verified:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Staff qualifications and training - Administrative records maintained on-site - Medication records - Daily activities and routines - Health and safety practices - Transportation of children - Child guidance practices <p>The QAM observed that the large stationary equipment in the outdoor play area remains inaccessible, as it has been blocked off since last summer pending repairs. The QAM reiterated the importance of ensuring children have access to all outdoor equipment, especially with the arrival of the summer months. The administrator</p>

advised that repairs are expected to be completed shortly and that the equipment will be made available to children real soon.

During the inspection, children were seen playing indoors and outdoors, and one group left for an outing. The QAM observed positive interactions between staff and children, such as educators getting down to the children's level to talk and engage with them. An educator was also observed reading a story to the children, who appeared very engaged.

While reviewing daily programming, the QAM noted that one educator did not have documented activities for the month of June. The educator explained that the beginning of June has been very busy due to preschool graduation, which was her main focus.

The QAM reminded both the educator and the administrator of the importance of planning and documenting daily programming. As of today, daily programming must resume.
