Comments: During the inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed that two classrooms only approved for school-age children were being used to accommodate preschool children. The operator of a licensed facility shall not change the allocation of space used to provide services or add to or alter any building or facility or any part of them unless the Minister has approved the changes in writing. A discussion took place with the operator regarding this matter. The operator advised that an application for the proposed changes, along with all required supporting documentation, was submitted in April 2026. The Quality Assurance Monitor acknowledged receipt of the Fire Prevention Plan Review in July 2026; however, the proposed changes have not yet received approval from the Fire Inspector, Health Inspector, or the Licensing Department. The operator stated that all classroom materials had already been relocated and that the children would continue to remain in those rooms. The Quality Assurance Monitor mentioned that none of the rooms currently identified on the licence are approved for sleeping. The operator indicated that, until all required approvals are obtained, the children will nap in the previously approved room designated for that purpose. The Quality Assurance Monitor again stated that preschool children are not permitted in those rooms. The Quality Assurance Monitor will contact the Fire Inspector and the Health Inspector.

Comments: During the inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed 18 full-time preschool children from licence (2015579) are in attendance under licence (2006893). However, this part-time licence is only approved for 10 morning preschool children. The number of children in attendance must not exceed the capacity stated on the licence. This licence is approved for 10 morning preschool children and 60 school-age children, with a maximum capacity of 60 children at any one time. A discussion took place with the operator regarding this matter. The operator advised that an application for the proposed changes, along with all required supporting documentation, was submitted in April 2026. The Quality Assurance Monitor acknowledged receipt of the Fire Prevention Plan Review in July 2026; however, the proposed changes have not yet received approval from the Fire Inspector, Health Inspector, or the Licensing Department. The operator indicated that all classroom materials had already been relocated and that the 18 preschool children would continue to remain in those rooms. The Quality Assurance Monitor stated that only the 10 morning preschool children or school-age children can be accommodated on this licence until the approval of all departments.			

General Comments
The Quality Assurance Monitor is on-site to conduct a monitoring inspection. The Quality Assurance Monitor is present during outdoor play, lunchtime, nap time, and indoor play periods. During transition periods, staff members are observed supporting and engaging positively with the children. The Quality Assurance Monitor verified the following items: - Ratio and maximum number of children - Administrative records maintained on-site - Premises - Outdoor play area - Outdoor play area materials and equipment - Safety - Transportation of children - New staff member files
