There were 2 children left in the bathroom and they were playing in the sink for several minutes until the licensing staff went to help them dry their hands to go into the lunchroom. Licensing staff advised Operator that the children cannot be left alone in the kitchen or bathroom during transitions. Please get the older children to wash their hands first and wait outside the door. Once you have washed the younger children's hands, you can all go to the lunch area together as discussed.

One of the children did not respond to the Operator when asked to do what they asked. The Operator began to count. Please review child guidance practices in the Operator Manuel.					
General Comments					
Nancy Glendenning and Lindsay Lewis arrived at facility to conduct the annual renewal inspection. The environment was chaotic and not organized into learning centres in a manner to promote learning for the children. The Operator was able to demonstrate that she is noting some of the children's experiences through her parent Facebook Page but evidence in the classroom was lacking. There was a web on the wall but when licensing staff asked to verify the progressive learning over the past year, the Operator stated that she did not					
have it in this section of the house. This will be verified on the next visit. Please visit curriculum documents to enhance the children's learning and the environment.					
The outdoor play area has many materials available to the children. Please ensure that they are cleaned on a regular basis and standing water from rain falls is removed prior to the children going outside. Tarps and some of the equipment had collected water and it was still there when licensing staff left the facility.					
Please take the expired items out of the First aid kit.
