Children engaged in play indoors, outdoors and in the gym this afternoon. Children have many opportunities to explore and create with tools. They have been working on a variety of woodworking/building projects.

General Comments

TV Room is set up with interesting materials and invitations for the children to explore. Signs at each station add literacy to the environment. This room is inviting and has an at home feel.

Multipurpose Room: (last group by kitchen) is in need of some attention. Materials depleted, shelves empty and bins unorganized. Adding labels to bins will help the children keep this area organized independently. How can you make this room more inviting for the children?

Discussed with educator EpiPen. Ensure that staff checks child's backpack each day to be sure that EpiPen arrives with child after school.

Discussed shared washrooms with administrator. Assigning specific groups to certain stalls/sinks could make cleaning more feasible. Signage or images could be posted in these areas as reminders for the children.
