The gym environment was not set-up today due to parent teacher interviews at the school. The children in this group went outdoors to play in the snow and were then going to join the other groups in the multi-purpose room as there were enough spaces available for them.

Group #5 - Environment is set-up in a way that is inviting for the older school-age children. Soft lighting, cozy furniture and plants have been added to the space; creating a place for the children hang out with their peers. Dramatic play materials have been added to expand on the children's interest in newscasting and playing office. QA Monitor encouraged staff to share their ideas with the other educators to create an inviting space for Group #3 and #4.

Handwashing routines were observed at arrival and before snack.

Monthly fire drills are documented.

Daily attendance records are accurate and reflect all children present. Child-to-staff ratio was observed to be met during Monitoring Inspection.

Incident logs were observed to be complete and signed by parents/guardians.
