<p>General Comments</p> <p>On the day of my monitoring visit, both the junior and senior babies were outside.</p> <p>At one point, two educators were left with 7 babies when the third educator went to take her morning break. When I brought this to the attention of the administrator, she had her relief staff join the group outdoors.</p>
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General Comments

I observed the educators getting the babies ready for lunch when they came inside. Educators were singing with the babies while lunch was being served.

In the two's room, I observed the children finger painting with green paint. The educators spoke kindly to the children and were patient. Learning stories and documentation are posted at the children's level. The filing cabinet has a lovely display of family photos and labels and the children really seem to enjoy this in their room.

The diapering areas in all three rooms were clean, organized and all was in order.

Attendance forms were checked and complete.

I checked the nap rooms and cribs are labelled and appropriately distanced apart. The nap rooms are clean and organized.
