<p>General Comments</p> <p>The following elements were verified at the time of the monitoring inspection:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> •The child to educator ratio. •For new staff members, the following were verified: criminal record check / vulnerable sector check, valid first aid certificate, valid CPR certificate, and job descriptions outlining roles and responsibilities. The educator printed the file of a new employee during the monitoring inspection. •The daily routine of the facility includes outdoor play for at least one hour for every four hour period. •Circulation areas and outdoor pedestrian pathways are free of obstacles and hazards. •The outdoor play area is covered with more than one type of surface material, allowing for different types of activities. •The outdoor play area is safe and clean. •Regarding outdoor play materials, there are dozens of balls (soccer and basketball) available outside. The quality assurance mentor observed the educator bringing out small bins containing chalk, coloring pencils, paper, and tracing objects. A discussion took place with the educator regarding the outdoor play materials. •Circulation areas and outdoor pedestrian pathways are free of obstacles and hazards. •Positive guidance of children. •Children wear a label indicating each child's name. <p>At the time of the surveillance inspection, in the afternoon, the quality assurance mentor observed indoor free play, outdoor free play, and a structured outdoor activity (coloring with wooden pencils on white paper).</p>
