## **General Comments**

Licensing Staff arrived to the Afterschool Centre and was greeted by the Afterschool Manager who conducted a very thorough Covid-19 screening. The Afterschool Manager asked the licensing staff the necessary Covid-19 questions and took the licensing staff's temperature.

Upon review of staff files it was noted that staff declarations stating that they have read and understood the Early Childhood Services Act were not up to date in the files located on site. When licensing staff asked the Afterschool Manager if there were updated versions of staff declarations the Afterschool Manager indicated that completed staff files are stored at their other location.

The Afterschool Manager made arrangements for the updated staff declarations to be dropped off while licensing staff was still conducting the renewal inspection.

When the licensing staff was inspecting the classrooms for toxic products it was noted that the cleaning supplies were being stored in a cabinet secured by a plastic child lock but not a lock and key. When this was brought to the Afterschool Manager's attention the Afterschool Manager immediately placed the products in a cabinet secured by a lock and key.
