<p><b>General Comments</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-Mid-Day visit to the establishment for an unexpected monitoring inspection</li> <li>-Ratio was respected during the visit</li> <li>-Posted in the entrance in the cubbies area are the following documents: The license, inspection report, orders for compliance, daily routine, evacuation procedures, name of administrator, name and telephone number of QA Monitor and inspector - Life threatening allergies</li> <li>-When it applies a notice to inform parents of the existence of a communicable disease is posted on the entrance door</li> <li>-The administrator as well as all educators have a valid first aid certificate</li> <li>-More than 50% of the staff have their one-year Early childhood education certificate</li> <li>-Toxic products, and cleaning supplies are locked under key and are inaccessible to children</li> <li>-The following administrative records are maintained on site: Daily attendance of children and staff, menus and any substitution, monthly emergency evacuation fire drills, smoke alarm, smoke detector and fire extinguisher inspection and maintenance records</li> <li>-Monthly emergency evacuation and fire drills are completed</li> <li>-In both rooms and the entrance, evidence of purposeful planning based on children's interest and learning, invitation, photos and learning stories were posted.</li> <li>-During the visit, it was observed that all educators are engaged with children at their level providing support and having conversations. Open-end questions are asked and guidance is given in a respectful and kind way</li> <li>-When going outside to play, the staff brings along a cart filled with play equipment. The material proposed is varied and in sufficient quantity for all children present</li> <li>-Outdoor play area is maintained safe and free of hazards.</li> </ul> <p>Observations: When arriving at the center children were exploring in sensory bins, today was an 80's day, music was playing and kids were dressed according to the theme. Once they were done with their play, they transitioned to snack and then played with the doll house. One staff went to get afterschool children who were arriving from school.</p>
