### General Comments

- Early-morning visit to the establishment for an unexpected monitoring inspection
- During the visit ratio was respected
- Major incident report was reviewed with the administrator on what incident is considered reportable and which one is not.
- Daily incident log is maintained, and signed by the parent
- Minor incident reports are maintained in the child's file
- During the visit, it was observed that all educators are engaged with children at their level providing support and having conversations.
- Outdoor play area consists of more than one surface to permit different types of play
- Outdoor material is varied and in sufficient quantity for all children present
- Outdoor play area is maintained safe
- The outdoor play area has at least 0.45m<sup>2</sup> of shade for each child based on the maximum number of children that can be accommodated in the outdoor play area
- Infants are supervised at all times when eating or drinking
- Infant bottles are stored with a cover in the refrigerator, labeled with the child's name and only used for the intended child
- Allergy information on any child is posted in the food preparation area
- Drinking water is provided throughout the day
- Infants are not fed while lying down
- Snacks and lunch are provided by the operator, parents have a three-day notice when changes are being made to the menu.

Observations: When arriving at the center, some groups were into a painting project, others were water playing and exploring with rice in discovery trays. Everybody had their snack and went outside for a playtime, once they came in, they all got ready for lunch and the youngest went down for naps.
