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<p><b>General Comments</b></p> <p>A monitoring inspection occurred in the morning.</p> <p>Preschool group Upstairs: The children were observed engaged in a variety of activities that included painting alongside their educator, using magnetic blocks, building with the blocks, engaged in dramatic play acting out role of a doctor. The educators indicated that the children are currently interested in drawing, trucks and cars, building with blocks, animals and learning about space.</p> <p>Preschool Group Downstairs: The children were observed engaged in a variety of activities that included using play dough alongside their educator, painting, playing with dinosaurs, and playing an action dice game alongside their educator. The educators indicated that the children are currently interested in colors, science activities, and learning about space.</p> <p>Both groups were observed getting ready to go for a walk.</p> <p>Positive child guidance techniques were observed. The educators were observed to be engaging at the children's level, providing appropriate supervision, using encouraging language, offering choices, and assisting children with decision-making.</p> <p>Several forms of documentation were visible throughout space, including photographs, learning stories, learning webs and children's artwork. The rooms were well-organized and inviting, offering a varied supply of age-appropriate materials, books, and toys.</p> <p>A clearly visible and prominent area was designated for posting the facility license, current monitoring reports, and any orders for compliance. Additional documents reviewed included incident logs, daily attendance records, a random review of ten child files, one staff file, and records of evacuation and monthly fire drills.</p>
