Comments: Group logs (Appendix C):Not being completed accurately. Most group log forms were missing date and date group established was not being recorded accurately. Discussed with operator and educators. Ensure any person who enters the room is recorded on the group log. The operator is to ensure that the relief personnel is a consistent person within the facility and within the groups of children they support. An infant was visiting the two year old group today to prepare for transitioning. This can not occur at this time. Once this child turns 2 years old, they can be moved to the 2 year old room and a new group will be established on the group log document. Paper towel was on washroom counter and not within mounted dispenser. Ensure this is checked and stored within dispenser to reduce contamination.

Comments: At time of inspection, the school aged children were playing/exploring in the wooded forest behind the facility. A swamp was noted to be next to this area which poses a safety concern as there is no fence or boundary separating the children from the water at this time. The children are not permitted to use this area at this time.

Comments: Previous comply by date of Feb. 10/20. White board easel within middle toddler room unclear. To be cleaned or replaced. Many books in various rooms are showing wear (torn/ripped). To be replaced or removed. Sensory magnet pieces within infant room are showing wear and unclear. These are very creative but difficult to clean. To be replaced or removed.

<p>General Comments</p> <p>Monitoring Inspection COVID-19 Recovery Phase. Screening protocols were followed upon entry to facility. Facility is using a contact thermometer for mid day checks. The indoor environment demonstrated a variety of the children's interests and there were some beautiful invitations set up for the children to explore. The sensory table within Margaret's room was set up with a creative invitation of toy frogs, and made great use of this piece of equipment. Observed two year old group during hand washing routines. Outdoor time was observed. The school aged children were observed being very creative within their outdoor environment. A very tall structure of plastic solo cups was also observed inside within the school aged children's indoor environment.</p> <p>Observed Extreme Allergy Management and Emergency Plan posted on wall within room. Please ensure that this plan is kept with the child's Epipen going forward, and accompanies the child/Epipen outdoors. Please review Appendix C (Group Log document) with all staff.</p>
