## **General Comments**

A Monitoring Inspection occurred on July 9, 2025.

Children were observed during both indoor and outdoor free play. Educators shared that the children are currently very interested in singing "The Wheels on the Bus," engaging with paint and hammers to create art, being active outdoors with water play, exploring open-ended art projects using a variety of materials, and going on neighbourhood walks. Educators were observed using positive language and offering gentle reminders. Outdoor educators were seen actively participating in and supporting children's play.

The daily incident log is maintained, and outdoor play is offered for at least one hour in each four-hour block when the majority of children are in attendance, weather permitting. All nap equipment meets the required minimum thickness of 5 cm, and the daily routine is posted in each room. Evacuation procedures are clearly posted in prominent locations. A communicable disease notice is visibly displayed to inform families as needed.

The facility has a varied supply of appropriate equipment, materials, books, and toys. Diaper-changing procedures are posted and visible to those completing diaper changes. Drinking water is available throughout the day, and infant bottles are labeled and used only for the intended child. Allergy information is clearly posted. The infant outdoor play area is used at separate times or is physically separate from other age groups. Outdoor stationary equipment is surrounded by protective surfacing of appropriate depth.

Various forms of literacy were observed throughout the indoor environment. A conversation took place with the Operator regarding the strengths and needs of the facility. Strengths identified included the completion of portfolios with the children and the presence of several forms of documentation throughout the facility. One area
