## **General Comments**

Inspector discussed outdoor supervision with the Administrator as it was observed during the inspection that one educator was sitting in the shaded area near the building and one educator stood in the play area adjacent to the building, however a small group of children were playing further away, near the parking lot, and could not be easily viewed by the staff. While supervising the outdoor play area, staff members must position themselves throughout and actively engage with the children. When the Inspectors walked down to the area where the children were playing, a staff member did begin to circulate and walked down to the small group of children to maintain adequate supervision over this part of the outdoor play area.

The children were provided with lots of outdoor play time, they had lots of room to run around and a variety of play structures to play on such as swings and monkey bars. More materials were available in the storage shed, however these need to be more readily available for children to access in the play area as they would have to ask staff to go get the items.
