<p>Comments:</p> <p>Inspector arrived at childcare facility to find a child in the hallway on the main level of the childcare center not with their group of children. Inspector asked another group of educators and children which group the child belonged to and was told which group it was. Inspector took the child up two flights of stairs and met the educator coming back down to retrieve the child that was not with them. Educator indicated another child ran away from them and they and the other children went after that child and this child was accidently left behind. Child was with Inspector for approximately 2-3 minutes before being retrieved by their educator.</p> <p>Operator to submit a plan to Inspector outlining how child-to-staff ratio will be maintained at all times during operational hours.</p>			

General Comments
<p>A monitoring inspection report was generated during an afternoon visit to the childcare facility.</p> <p>Inspector recommends the following:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. <input type="checkbox"/> During transitions to outside and inside that the educators do not divide the children and bring them to the childcare learning environments from two different sets of stairs but remain together.</li> <li>2. <input type="checkbox"/> Staff members are to conduct frequent head counts indoors and outdoors to ensure children's safety. Educators must always supervise all children in their care by positioning themselves in the indoor and outdoor environments to have an unobstructed view of the children as they play, and during transition times such as bathroom routine and moving from indoor to outdoor play. Staff must always be aware of the location of all</li> </ol>
