General Comments					

A Monitoring Inspection took place on September 26, 2024.

During the visit, children were observed engaging in indoor free play and snack time, with proper handwashing practices noted during the transition to snack. Educators shared that the children are currently very interested in dramatic play and have been taking the lead in their activities, including a particular interest in making pompoms. Educators were observed using positive language and offering gentle reminders to the children.

The facility is well-maintained, with a daily incident log kept, and parents of children present are allowed entry at any time. Outdoor play is ensured for at least one hour in each four-hour block, weather permitting. Monthly emergency evacuations are completed and posted, and the license, current inspection report, monitoring reports, and orders for compliance are displayed in a prominent location. The daily routine and evacuation procedures are also posted in visible areas.

The learning environment is thoughtfully arranged with several well-defined centers for building, reading, dramatic play, and science. The sensory area is well-stocked with sufficient quantities of materials, and accessories are rotated regularly. Books that reflect the children's interests have been selected, and toxic products such as cleaners are securely locked away.

Regarding the curriculum, daily activities are intentionally planned and documented, providing opportunities for both individual and group experiences. Various forms of literacy are integrated into the indoor environment, supporting the children's development.
