Inspector observed documentation of the children's learnings in the classrooms, such as activities and materials surrounding the topic of Outerspace, and Groundhog Day. Inspector also saw materials for future activities for Valentine's Day. Inspector observed that books are at the children's disposal regarding these various themes.

A child's EpiPen has expired. Educator indicates that they will contact the parent to obtain a new one.
