<p>General Comments</p> <p>The following elements were verified at the time of the monitoring inspection:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -The child–educator ratio. -The facility's daily routine includes outdoor play for at least one hour during every four-hour period. -Circulation areas as well as outdoor pedestrian pathways are free of obstacles and hazards. -The fixed equipment is surrounded by a protective surface. The operator must ensure that a protective surface is maintained near impact areas, such as at the bottom of a slide or at the bottom of a ladder leading up to the fixed play structure. -The outdoor play area is safe and clean. -There are a few toy trucks in the outdoor play area. The quality-assurance mentor noticed that two boys were arguing over one truck. No other trucks were available at the time of the inspection, and there was one ball that was not accessible (in the fenced garden). The quality-assurance mentor discussed the importance of providing a variety of materials in sufficient quantity, such as trucks, shovels, balls, etc. -Circulation areas as well as outdoor pedestrian pathways are free of obstacles and hazards. <p>During the morning monitoring inspection, the quality-assurance mentor observed an activity about the bee life cycle and how bees make honey. There was a tree with an old empty beehive used as a demonstration. The educator then gathered paintbrushes, paint, and paper and brought the children outside so they could paint their own bee. Another group was engaged in free play outdoors. During outdoor free play, the educator positioned herself at the child's level to intervene regarding a child's behavior.</p>
