General Comments					
A Monitoring Inspection took place on September 16, 2024.					
During the inspection, children were observed engaging in both indoor and outdoor free play. Educators shared that the children are currently very interested in making crafts, playing games indoors, being active on the playground outdoors, and even creating choreography for music videos! Outdoors, educators were actively involved in the children's activities. The facility ensures that outdoor play occurs for at least one hour in each four-hour block when the majority of children are in attendance, weather permitting. The daily routine is posted in each room, and evacuation procedures are clearly displayed in a prominent location. The room setup is inviting, with materials thoughtfully arranged to encourage play. A varied supply of appropriate equipment, materials, books, and toys is readily available. Toxic products, such as cleaning chemicals, are securely locked and inaccessible to the children. Drinking water is provided throughout the day, and outdoor stationary equipment is surrounded by protective surfacing of adequate depth. In terms of the curriculum, children are offered opportunities for both individual and group experiences. They have the chance to express creativity, explore the arts and sciences, experience accomplishments, problem-solve, and develop trusting, respectful, and supportive relationships.
