General Comments

Upon Licensing staff arrival for the renewal inspection, classrooms were observed preparing for photos and having circle time.

The main entry way was bright and inviting. Each age group had a parent board posted in the main entry with a monthly calendar of activities, current learning stories and required licensing documentation. Children's personal belongings were neat and tidy in cubbies and communicable disease postings were visible. The classrooms were organized, and material was in good condition. Bins of open-ended material were labelled, and cozy corners with accessible literacy material and dramatic play stations were set up. Educators were observed reading stories and using vibrant voices which captured the children's attention.

Later in the morning, proper handwashing was observed prior to snack time. During snack, the children sat together at the tables and Educators were engaged in conversation with the children. After snack, the children from each classroom prepared to go outdoors to play. Headcounts were observed by each Educator prior to leaving the classroom, before leaving the entry way and before entering the fenced in area. The outdoor play space had an ample amount of material for the children to play with. Children were observed playing with Tonka trucks, sidewalk chalk, and on the wooden play structure. An Educator was observed offering hugs and caring words after a child had tiny tumble. As a reminder, with the spring and summer months, please ensure that shade sails are in place. When coming back indoors to prepare for lunch, proper handwashing was observed again.

During lunch, an Educator from the 3-year-old room was observed singing "bon appetite" to the children while another Educator was observed assisting with lunch containers and packaging. One of the 4-year-old classrooms took their lunch outdoors to eat in the play space at the picnic tables. After lunch, the tables were cleaned, and the floors were swept. During quiet time in the 3-year-old room, children were observed playing with natural loose play pieces, colouring and playing with blocks as some friends rested.
