## **General Comments**

A Monitoring Inspection occurred on April 10, 2025.

Children were observed engaging in both indoor and outdoor free play, as well as during snack time. During the transition indoors, proper handwashing procedures were followed and observed.

Educators reported that the children are currently very interested in being active outdoors, flying kites, participating in science experiments, making homemade ice cream, and working together on a 1000-piece puzzle as a group project. Throughout the visit, educators were observed using positive language and offering gentle reminders to support children's self-regulation.

Educators have incorporated their own interests into documentation, helping to build stronger relationships and foster a sense of community within the environment. Outdoors, educators played an active role in children's activities, supporting exploration and engagement. A daily incident log is maintained and reviewed regularly. Monthly emergency evacuation drills are completed and the corresponding records are visibly posted. The daily routine and evacuation procedures are also posted and clearly visible in a prominent location.

The facility offers a varied supply of developmentally appropriate equipment, materials, books, and toys. Several well-defined learning centers were observed, including spaces dedicated to building, reading, dramatic play, and science. Traffic areas were kept clean, and outdoor walkways were free of clutter and debris. Drinking water is available to children throughout the day, and the outdoor stationary equipment is surrounded by protective surfacing of appropriate depth to support safe play. Various forms of literacy were present in the indoor environment, and several examples of documentation were displayed throughout the facility, highlighting the children's learning and experiences.
