A renewal inspection occurred today. The children were observed indoors engaged in free play in their environment. The children were excited to show licensing their play kitchen and made delicious breakfast to "eat" while they showed off their center.

Educators were engaged with the children on their level and exploring "sharks" and listened carefully to each child and gave time for them to express their thoughts and feelings.

Within the environment, each space was flexible to accommodate children's emerging interests. There was space for risk taking and vigorous play.

Educators respected children's independence and modeled participation.

The outdoor area had lots of different forms of open-ended materials, such as the kitchen set with real repurposed materials. The environments were at children's level and represented children's home and community environments.
