The QAM called the facility twice with no answer and the answering machine was full. The QAM called the administrator's personal phone after 15 minutes. The administrator informed the QAM that 2 educators were inside, and 2 educators were at school for pick up. The administrator shared that the educators might not have heard the bell nor the phone ring. When children are present, parents shall have access to the facility at all times. The operator must ensure that educators are able to great access to the parents. If a parent were to arrive during that time, they would
