General Comments

The following elements were verified during the monitoring inspection:

- The child–educator ratio
- The criminal record check / vulnerable sector check, the valid first aid certificate, the valid cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) certificate, as well as the job descriptions outlining duties and responsibilities were verified for the new staff members.
- Daily activities. An observation was made of a child engaged in individual reading (pretending to read a book and looking at the pictures). Another observation involved a group of children building roads and playing with small cars.
- Positive guidance of children. The educator encourages the children to wash their hands. Another educator redirects a child who does not wish to follow the group by positively reinforcing the children who are following the instruction and by naming the child, saying: "Thank you for coming with us."
- The facility. Indoor circulation areas as well as outdoor pedestrian pathways are free of obstacles and hazards.
- Diaper changing. The diaper-changing procedure was observed. The children are adequately supervised, and the procedure is followed according to requirements, including handwashing for both the baby and the educator.
- Food and hydration. At the time of the inspection, each child had access to their water bottle.

There are crafts and drawings of green shamrocks displayed in several classrooms.

During the monitoring inspection, the quality assurance mentor observed, in the morning, structured play, free play, the toileting routine, diaper changing, handwashing, and lunch.
