During the monitoring inspection, the daily attendance records of children were not accessible in each group. The administrator informed the Quality Assurance Monitor that the facility has put a new electronic application in place to take the daily attendance of the children, the attendance is taken at the door on an I pad that remains at the door. The administrator voiced that the application put in place is more efficient for the facility and confirmed that at the end of each week, the daily attendance can be printed out on the forms provided by the Minister if needed. The Quality Assurance Monitor reminded the administrator that daily attendance of children must be on forms provided by the Minister. The Quality Assurance Monitor also reminded the administrator that each educator responsible for a group of children should always have an attendance sheet with them to ensure each educator knows what child they are responsible for. The administrator voiced that it would be ineffective and a lot less efficient than the application that was put in place.
