Children and Educators observed in the indoor and outdoor play environments.

The indoor environment is purposefully planned to reflect the interests and abilities of the children with invitations and a variety of easily accessible materials. Documentation of recent activities and learning are posted at the children's level allowing opportunities for them to revisit and expand/ extend their work. Ensure all documentation is dated.

Educators were observed engaging in play along side children, offering encouragement, listening as they spoke and asking open-ended questions.

anticipating children's needs, and using positive language when interacting with children.

Ensure the year is added to weekly attendance records and that all incident logs have the care provided added.

For children with extreme allergies, it is recommended that a copy of the plan be available in the play space and the original placed in the child's file. All staff who may have contact with the child(ren) are to be familiar and aware of the contents of the plan.
