Comments: Operator has not completed 10 hours of PL in the past licensing year. As discussed with operator during inspection, 10 hours of professional learning is one requirement of maintaining designation status and license renewal.			
31(3) An operator shall maintain the outdoor play area of a licensed facility to ensure the safety of the children.	31(3)	Sep 15, 2023	
Comments: School age outdoor play area next to building- "Zip line" in poor repair. Two taped loops at one end are to be removed immediately to ensure the safety of the children. Climbing dome is placed on grass. Climbing dome is required to be as installed as per manufacturer instructions and requires surfacing. Children cannot use this play equipment until adequate surfacing is installed.			
32(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall provide indoor play area materials and equipment that are (d) clean and in good repair.	32(1)(d)	Sep 15, 2023	
Comments: School-age room- debris collecting on rug in dramatic play area. Rugs are to be vacuumed at least daily or more frequently when necessary.			

General Comments

Renewal inspection completed today.

Children and educators were observed during indoor and outdoor play, transitions and preparing for lunch. School age and preschool children returned from play in the outdoors and had group time. Their educators read stories and engaged with the children in conversation and questions related to the book.

Indoor environments were purposefully planned with a variety of materials and invitations to play and learning set up for children.

Documentary evidence of children's learning was posted throughout the indoor play environments and highlighted recent activities, topics of interest and learning of both groups.

Operator reports that painting of the entire building is scheduled to be completed. Inspector or QA Monitor will follow up.
