This afternoon, June 19, 2024, a Monitoring Inspection occurred.

During the inspection, children were observed during their afternoon snack. The educator noted that the children are currently very excited about the upcoming summer weeks. The children have collaborated on a project where each week they will travel to a different country, exploring unique aspects of the culture, for example: food and traditions. They have even created passports using loose parts materials to support their imaginative journey around the world.

The educator was observed using positive language and providing gentle reminders. Additionally, the educator engaged in discussions with the children by asking questions and expanding on the ideas they presented.

The facility maintains all required records and documents for a year, including a daily incident log. Parents of children present at the center are granted entry at any time. A clearly visible and prominent place is available for posting the license, current inspection report, current monitoring reports, and orders for compliance. Evacuation procedures are also posted in a prominent location. The daily routine is displayed in the room, which is set up in an inviting manner.

The materials arranged in the room encourage children to play, and ideas from various web resources and learning stories are reflected in the art area, library, kitchen, and dramatic play areas. Books selected in the room reflect the children's interests.

The curriculum includes daily activities that are purposefully planned and documented in the program, offering opportunities for both individual and group experiences. Various forms of literacy are present in the indoor environment, enhancing the learning experience for the children.
