General Comments						
A Monitoring Inspection occurred on July 9, 2025.						
Children were observed during both indoor and outdoor free play. Educators noted that the children are currently very interested in ocean animals, exploring different bug species outdoors, going for neighbourhood walks, and participating in outdoor water play. Educators were observed using positive language and offering gentle reminders to guide children's behavior in a respectful and supportive manner.						
The daily incident log is maintained, and outdoor play occurs for at least one hour in each four-hour block of time when the majority of children are in attendance, weather permitting. The daily routine is posted in each room. Evacuation procedures are clearly posted in a prominent location, and a notice regarding a communicable disease is visibly displayed to inform families. Allergy information for children is also posted.						
Books reflecting the children's interests are available and well-integrated into the environment. Well-defined learning and play areas were observed, and children's artwork is displayed throughout the facility. Traffic areas and outdoor walkways are kept clean and free of clutter, and drinking water is made available throughout the day. Outdoor stationary equipment is surrounded by protective surfacing of appropriate depth.						
Educators provide opportunities for both individual and group experiences, fostering a balanced and inclusive learning environment. A conversation took place with the Operator regarding the strengths and needs of the facility. One strength identified was the active role outdoor educators play in engaging with children's interests and activities. One area for improvement discussed was the importance of updating fire drill records on the same day the drills are conducted to ensure accurate documentation.
