It is recommended the Operator request a new updated Essential routine services and Emergency plan to post or create one that includes the information in (appendix 5 in the manual) to ensure the child in the classroom discussed has had any changes to health or medical condition. This needs to be updated annually and signed off by the parent.

Just an observation, to keep children's lunch boxes closed when children are finished their snack/lunch to keep the food not eaten cold for afternoon snack or eat foods that would easily spoil first. I noticed some lunch boxes not closed after eating snack.

It is recommended that children wear indoor shoes for safety and also in the event of fire drills.

Educators were observed engaged with the children during my visit and children were involved in a variety of programming activities. I did not observe outdoor play, and it is a requirement to enjoy outdoor play in the AM and PM.

This facility will be relocating this summer and the operator will advise me once Fire and Health have approved the new space for continued licensing.

This facility is meeting the training requirements for section 11 in the regulation. One staff graduates this June with her ECE certificate.
