Arrived to perform a monitoring inspection. Megan Munden was also present for the inspection. Upon arrival all children registered for the program were participating in an after-school basketball program.

Children completed the basketball program and were in attendance at the after-school program at 2:45. The room was well organized with sufficient materials that were developmentally appropriate and based on the children's current interests. Leprechaun traps remained from last week's activities and an about the author board was a nice addition to the reading area. The reading area contained a variety of book series that were appropriate for school aged children and were displayed in a way that was inviting.

The educator was observed to use appropriate behaviour guidance and appropriate interactions with children at all times, providing positive behavioural guidance when needed. Children were given the opportunity for long-term projects and were not required to clean up all materials prior to eating, which allowed them to continue adding to their play.
