Comments: Upon review, one staff file was missing a description of duties and responsibilities; this was corrected before I completed the inspection.			

General Comments
<p>I was greeted at the doors by an educator and shown around the facility and introduced to the staff and children.</p> <p>Staff sat on the floor or at tables with children during activities like reading, colouring, stacking blocks, and playing in the sandbox outside. Staff comforted and maintained consistent patience and encouragement for children when they had moments of struggling with their emotions. Educators were in tune with and receptive to the children's needs to enrich their play; I observed one infant educator sweeping the patio stones in the outdoor play space when one infant was getting their wheeled toys stuck in the sand and pea gravel that had moved onto the path as the older children played earlier in the day.</p> <p>The staff worked well together, particularly during transitions to ensure that ratio was maintained, their play spaces were kept clean, and that children had the level of individual support they needed from educators.</p> <p>The centre was well-organized in the classroom's activities, outdoor activities, and their files. There was a wide variety of activities in each classroom and all books, supplies, and toys were observed in good condition. There were options to engage in activities organized by the educator, like crafts, or to engage in free play.</p> <p>Pending passing their annual fire and health inspections, I recommend this license for renewal.</p>
