General Comments

Upon arrival, Licensing Staff Laura Casey and Troy Williams entered the Chicken Coop Room. The room had recent learning stories posted about bears, toys such as a play kitchen, dress up clothes, books and a tool set. The children arrived and began to play before getting ready to go outdoors.

The Treehouse Room also has recent learning stories posted as well as family photos and crafts. There are open shelves of toys with blocks and trucks, books and play matts. The children's belongings were organized and clearly labeled.

The Dino Den Room children we getting ready to go outdoors. Educators were applying sunscreen and getting the children's water bottles and hats ready. The Dino Den had a large doll house, dinosaurs, a chalk board, dramatic play space and toys. Learning stories were posted and posted throughout the room.

The Angel Fish Room was organized and learning stories were posted throughout the room. Toys such as books, a wooden cubby structure set up as an imaginary pond, a chalk table, cars, crafts and dress up clothes were readily available.

The Butterfly House Room Educators were engaged and getting the children ready to go outside with sunscreen, water bottles and hats. The children held hands and proceeded outside. The room was tidy and organized with toys and art centres.

The outdoor play space was inviting with flowers and toys. Licensing staff observed the children entre the space and begin to play with the sandbox, balance bikes, balls, water tables and a bowling activity. Educators were engaged and played with the children at the water tables and the hose. Later on, during the outdoor play, crayons were brought outside and some children sat with chairs and coloured. Water breaks were observed multiple times during outdoor play time.

The transition inside from outdoor play was timely and children assisted in cleaning up the toys when then infants returned from their walk. Upon returning inside, the children washed their hands and prepared to have lunch. Educators were observed sitting with the children and talking about their lunches.
