<p><b>General Comments</b></p> <p><b>Big Room</b> During the visit, children were engaged in a variety of activities. Several children explored a dinosaur-themed invitation, while others participated in train play, puzzles, and coloring. A collaborative project was underway in which children were constructing a police station using a large cardboard box. Police-themed dress-up clothing was available inside the structure, and children were actively creating wheels to attach to a separate box designated as a police car. Both educators and children demonstrated strong engagement and collaboration throughout the project. The room was well-equipped with a wide range of toys, art materials, literacy resources, and dramatic-play opportunities, providing children with multiple choices for meaningful play.</p> <p><b>Infant Room</b> Infants were engaged in an animal-themed activity where animals were hidden under paper for the children to discover. Educators participated alongside the children, supporting exploration and interaction. Infants also engaged with sensory pads featuring a variety of textures and colors. Educators reported that the children currently show strong interest in animals, sensory experiences, and music. The room contained ample materials and supplies, and educators remained on the floor actively engaged with the children throughout the visit.</p> <p>Child ratios and staff files were reviewed and found to be accurate and up to date.</p>
