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General Comments -Morning visit to the establishment for an unexpected monitoring inspection -Ratio was respected during the visit -Administration of medication records are evident -Medication are locked and stored inaccessible to children -Prescribed medication are found on site, they are labeled with the doctor's name, instructions, and the time period for use -Medication used for anaphylactic shock (EPIPEN) are stored safely (inaccessible to children) but easy to access for staff -The activities offered to children during the summer season are planned as a range of different options that were shared with parents through a pamphlet distributed at the beginning of the summer. This plan remains flexible; today, the children are making puppets. This activity was added spontaneously following a discussion with a staff member. -During the visit, it was observed that all educators are engaged with children at their level providing support and having conversations. Open-end questions are asked and guidance is given in a respectful and kind way -Allergy information on any child is posted in the food preparation area -Drinking water is provided throughout the day -Food brought from home is labeled with the child's name and refrigerated or has an ice pack as required -Outdoor material is varied and in sufficient quantity for all children present -Outdoor play area is maintained safe and free of hazards -Outdoor play area consists of more than one surface to permit different types of play Observations: Upon my arrival, the majority of the group went outside to play, while a small number remained indoors because they were engaged in a project. One educator is preparing the puppets for the activity scheduled for the afternoon.
