General Comments

- -Mid-morning visit to the establishment for an unexpected monitoring inspection
- -Ratio was respected in all groups during the visit
- -The daily information sheet for infants (0-24 months information about the child's mood, eating schedule, rest time, diaper changing) is completed every day and stored in a file that is kept into the room
- -Monthly evacuation fire drills are completed
- -During the visit, it was observed that all educators are engaged with children at their level providing support and having conversations.
- -In all rooms, evidence of purposeful planning based on children's interest and learning, webbing, invitation, photos and learning stories were posted.
- Material and equipment proposed to children in the indoor play area are easily accessible on low, open shelves. It is varied and in sufficient quantity for all children present.
- -Material and equipment offered to the children in the indoor play area is safe, clean and in good repair.
- -The designated napping spaces within the center is the classrooms. Each napping child has a cot that is appropriate for their height and is in good repair, all nap equipment is washable and non-absorbent
- -Administrator and staff confirm that part of the bedding material are washed weekly by themselves (sheets) and the blankets are sent home on Friday and washed by the parents
- -Toxic products, and cleaning supplies are locked under key and are inaccessible to children
- -Each child has an easily accessible space to store their personal belongings, which is labeled with their name and used only for the intended child.
- -Diaper changing station is found in the infant's room and in all washrooms in the center, individual space is provided for diapers and changing necessities. The changing table is equipped with a safety strap and covered with a non-absorbent layer, it is separated from the food preparation and is located one meter or less from a sink and children are always supervised during diaper changing.

Observations: When arriving at the center children were finishing their snack, afterwards most groups started working on their Christmas gifts for their parents. Today is a very cold day, no group went outside to play. After a free play period, all group cleaned up and got ready for lunch, the youngest transitioned to nap time while the oldest kids were playing tabletop games and having a quiet period.
