Open-end questions are asked and guidance is given in a respectful and kind way -Toxic products, and cleaning supplies are locked under key and are inaccessible to children -Outdoor play area consists of more than one surface to permit different types of play and exploration, the material offered is varied and in sufficient quantity for children present -Outdoor play area is maintained safe and free of hazards. -The four-year-old group are talking about what they love about Spring, the three-year-old are all about different species of animals and the two's are experimenting with compost.
