General Comments
Licensing staff arrived at the facility at 9:30am. Upon arriving, the two-year-old classroom was heading outside to play in the playground. The other classrooms were observed engaged in free play activities such as playing "the floor is lava" with balloons, in the dramatic play kitchen and dolls. Once it was time to transition, a verbal prompt was given to the children to clean up their activities. The educators were observed cleaning up with the children while praising them for cleaning up. Once the classrooms were properly cleaned up, the educators were heard asking the children to line up at the doors. A head count was completed, and the children were guided to the washrooms. One by one, the children used the washroom and diapers were changed. One educator was heard asking questions and making conversation with the children while they waited to use the washroom. Hands were washed before returning to the classroom for morning snack time. The educators were observed sanitizing the tables before inviting the children to gather their lunch boxes and sitting down at the tables to eat. Later, the educators and children headed towards the entrance to change the children's shoes and apply sunscreen before heading outside. The educators verified the temperature and ensured that the children were properly dressed to go play in the playground. A head count was done before heading outside. The educators asked the children to find a walking partner and ensured that the children were safe while crossing the parking lot. While outside, the children were observed engaging in various activities such as playing on the large structure, in the mud kitchen area and in the new dramatic playhouse. An educator was observed sitting at a table with a group of children while making "soups and salads" with sand, rocks, and vegetables from the garden. Another educator was observed digging, scooping and playing in the sandbox area with a group of children. The educators supervised the children at play and frequently encouraged water breaks. Daily attendance, first aid bags and water bottles were present outside. A verbal prompt was given to the children to signal an upcoming transition. The children and educators were observed cleaning up the playground and placing materials in the storage areas before going inside. Once inside, the educators helped the children put away their personal belongings on their hooks. The children's hands were washed before lunch and the educators were observed heating up some of the children's food and

supervising them while they ate. The indoor environment was clean and well organized. The washrooms were clean and the children's personal belongings were properly stored and labelled. The necessary information was posted in a visible place.
