Comments: The cabinets in the kitchen and the washroom where is kept the toxic and cleaning products is locked with a plastic child proof lock. The cabinets must be locked with a key lock.			
39(2) A licensed facility shall have a separate locked storage space that is inaccessible to the children for each of the following: (b) medications.	39(2)(b)	Jun 02, 2021	
Comments: The cabinet where is kept the medicine is locked with a plastic child proof lock. The cabinet must be locked with a key lock.
