Comments: The parents or guardian of a child receiving services at the licence facility should have access to a licence facility at any time when the child is present. The operator must review section 10.1 page 71 from the operator's manual.			
39(2) A licensed facility shall have a separate locked storage space that is inaccessible to the children for each of the following: (a) toxic products, chemical products and cleaning supplies;	39(2)(a)	Jul 28, 2022	
Comments: While conducting the renewal inspection, the inspector observed the toxic products stored in the bathroom cabinet. The lock of the cabinet was loose and unsecured to children. A child would have been able to open the cabinet. The operator must ensure an appropriate lock to ensure the safety of the children. The operator advises the inspector that a new secure lock will be put in place. There was a toxic product on the side of the bath tub, The operator removed the Lysol and put it where it was not accessible to the children. In the kitchen there was a gallon of paint on the floor. The operator must store the paint in a locked storage where it's not accessible to children.			
48(4) If an infant is receiving services at a licensed facility, the operator shall (b) ensure that an infant who is bottle-fed is not fed in a crib.	48(4)(b)	Jul 28, 2022	
Comments: While conduction the renewal inspection, the inspector observed the operator give a bottle of milk to a child lying down in the crib. It is prohibited to give a bottle to a child while lying down. Like stated in section 12 page 89 of the operator's manual if an infant is receiving services at a licensed facility, the operator must ensure that an infant that is bottle fed is not fed in a crib.			
48(4) If an infant is receiving services at a licensed facility, the operator shall (c) supervise an infant while he or she eats or drinks.	48(4)(c)	Jul 28, 2022	
Comments: While conduction the renewal inspection, the inspector observed the operator give a bottle of milk to a child unsupervised lying down in the crib. Like stated in section 12 page 89 in the operator's manual if an infant is receiving services at a licence facility, The operator shall supervise an infant while he or she eats or drinks.

While conducted the renewal inspection, the inspector had a conversation with the operator about the date on the daily information sheet. The date should always be marked on the sheets.

General Comments

The inspector was not able to observe the children go outside in the playground. Will observe while conducting the follow-up inspection.

The inspector had a discussion with the operator regarding section 9.3.2 page 70 in the operator's manual regarding recalls.
