Operator indicates that as the ground is still unthawing, the protective surfacing for the stationary equipment has not yet been tilled. Operator indicates that this will be done as soon as possible. A conversation was had between the Operator and the Inspector regarding a play structure that has been installed on pavement. Inspector recommends that Operator verify the manufacturer's manual to see if a protective surfacing is required for this type of equipment.

Operator must ensure that the Quality Assurance Monitor's (QAM) contact information is up to date on the parent board. Inspector provided Operator with the current QAM's contact information.

A discussion was had between the Operator and the Inspector with regards to modifications that must be made to the Parent Handbook. Operator must provide parents and the inspector with a new copy of the handbook.
