## General Comments

A Monitoring Inspection occurred December 9, 2024.

During the visit, children were observed engaged in indoor free play and snack time. Proper handwashing practices were noted during the transition to snack time. Steps or platforms were provided to allow children to access regular-sized toilets and sinks with ease.

Educators shared that the children are currently interested in topics such as transportation, dinosaurs, and Christmas decorating. Positive language and gentle reminders were consistently observed in their interactions with the children.

The facility maintains a daily incident log and ensures parents are advised of incidents through completed incident report forms when necessary. Parents of children attending the center are allowed entry at any time. Outdoor play is incorporated for at least one hour in each four-hour block of time, weather permitting. Monthly emergency evacuations are completed and appropriately posted for reference.

The indoor environment is thoughtfully set up and inviting, with materials designed to encourage active play and exploration. Ideas from web resources and learning stories are evident in the art area, library, kitchen, and dramatic play areas. Books reflecting the children's current interests have been carefully selected.

Traffic areas and outdoor walkways are kept clean and free of clutter. Toxic products, such as cleaning supplies, are securely locked and inaccessible to children. The changing area is located within one meter of a sink, and diaper-changing procedures are visibly posted for reference during diaper changes. The infant outdoor play area is used separately or at different times from the areas designated for older children.

The curriculum is purposefully planned, with daily activities documented in the program. Both individual and group learning opportunities are available, and various forms of literacy are incorporated into the indoor environment.
