## **General Comments**

Comments:

A Monitoring Inspection occurred on February 10, 2025.

Deficiency is now compliant

Children were observed during indoor free play and snack time. They engaged in various activities that reflected their interests. Educators shared that the children are currently exploring themes such as restaurants and favourite foods, experimenting with snow and ice through painting and art, participating in music and movement activities, and creating Valentine's bags for Valentine's Day. Educators were observed using positive language and providing gentle reminders to support children's interactions and transitions. Additionally, they have included their own interests in documentation, fostering a connection between their experiences and the children's learning.

The daily incident log is maintained, and parents are informed of incidents. Outdoor play occurs for at least one hour during each four-hour block when most children are in attendance, weather permitting. Monthly emergency evacuations are conducted and posted for review. The daily routine is displayed in each room, and evacuation procedures are posted in a prominent location. The facility features well-defined learning and play areas, with children's artwork displayed throughout the space. Toxic products, such as chemical cleaners, are securely locked and inaccessible to children. The changing area is located within one meter of a sink, and diaperchanging procedures are posted for reference. Drinking water is available throughout the day. Infant bottles are labeled and designated for individual use. The infant outdoor play area is separate or used at different times than other age groups.

Children's portfolios are actively maintained. Various forms of documentation were observed throughout the facility. Educators have collaborated with children to create and expand upon webs, demonstrating an evolving and responsive curriculum.
