The Quality Assurance Monitor is on site for a monitoring inspection. During the inspection the Quality Assurance Monitor was able to observe the children during free play, during circle time and during transition periods. The Quality Assurance monitor observed positive interventions and positive discipline in the afterschool group. A circle time discussion in the preschool group and in the upstairs afterschool group was also observed. The educators were activating the children's prior knowledge and generating new interests to lead them to a planned activity. The afterschool circle time activity also promoted positive relationships amongst the children. The Quality Assurance monitor had a discussion with the Operator about consistent class management strategies and positive child guidance.
