Comments: Children's attendance is being recorded on sheets created by the operator and staff are updating the attendance form provided by the department weekly, however children's attendance must be completed by staff on the form provided by the department each time a child arrives and leaves; they must be accurate ar reflect all children present at any given time; they must be easily accessible to all staff members; and are to be taken out of the facility whenever children leave the building.							
General Comments							
The QA Monitor discussed the amendments to the Act with the Administrator and clarified that the directors and/or administrators, including the Boards of non-profit organizations, must have a criminal record check or vulnerable sector check. A record of suitability with the Department of Social Development is also required if they have contact with children or responsible for finances as part of their role. The vulnerable sector check must be completed for those people that have contact with children at the facility. The Administrator advised that they have completed the checks for all but one and that once they are all completed they will update the Department. The QA Monitor and the Administrators also discussed how they can support educators to demonstrate they are achieving compliance to regulation 21 The daily activities of a licensed facility shall be purposely planned in advance and documented and shall respond to the capabilities, needs and interests of each child. QA Monitor will send some sample planning tools and articles that discuss reflective practice to the Administrator.
