General Comments
<p>Licensing Staff arrived to perform a Monitoring Inspection. Upon arrival two children were napping while three others were playing quietly. The environment is calm and inviting, with soft music playing in the background. The Operator mentioned a few of the children have been showing an interest in the mop, so one child was helping mop the floors. The Operator was heard giving praises to the child, "Excellent job!".</p> <p>Throughout the visit the Operator was seen hugging, singing and engaging with the children. They read a story together, "Flotsam" By David Wiesner. The Operator often stopped to engage the children by asking questions related to the story, "What do you think is living in there", "What would you do if you found a camera at the beach".</p> <p>The room is bright and offers a variety of materials for the children such as building blocks, crayons, markers, books, a play kitchen and dolls. There are natural elements throughout the room such as plants, rocks, moss and stick bugs. Documentation such as learning stories, pictures and artwork is posted on the walls. The children appear comfortable with the Operator and environment.</p>
