<p>General Comments</p> <p>A Monitoring Inspection occurred in the morning.</p> <p>Infant Room: The children were observed engaging in a variety of activities, including coloring at the table, playing with farm animals, and pushing the sit to stand walkers. Educators indicated that the children are currently interested in sensory experiences, particularly water play, as well as schema-based play such as dumping and filling.</p> <p>Two-year-old Room: The children were observed engaging in a variety of activities that included drawing and using stamps at the table, exploring the farm felt board with felt animals, playing with trucks, and listening to music. Educators indicated that the children are currently interested in firetrucks, books, learning about their body parts, and participating in gross motor activities.</p> <p>Three-Year old Room: The children were observed engaging in a variety of activities, including using playdough at the table alongside their educator, looking at books, playing with baby dolls, and exploring the kitchen centre. The educator indicated that the children are currently interested in dramatic play, specifically related to family, animals, and cooking.</p> <p>Four-Year-Old Room: The children were observed engaging in a variety of activities, including rough and tumble play, playing with superhero figurines, and washing cars as part of a tuff tray activity. The educator indicated that the children are currently interested in cars, sensory activities, dinosaurs, and superheroes.</p> <p>Several forms of documentation were visible throughout all rooms, including photographs, learning stories, learning webs, and children's artwork. Books were selected to reflect the children's interests.</p> <p>Traffic areas, both indoors and outdoors, were maintained in a clean and clutter-free condition. A clearly visible</p>

and prominent area was designated for posting the facility license, current monitoring reports, and any orders for compliance. Additional documents reviewed included incident logs, daily attendance records, daily information sheets, a random review of ten child files, five staff files, and records of evacuation and monthly fire drills.
