### General Comments

- Mid-day visit to the establishment for an unexpected monitoring inspection
- Ratio was respected during the visit
- Posted on top of the cubbies are the following documents: The license, inspection report, orders for compliance, daily routine, evacuation procedures, name of administrator, name and telephone number of QA Monitor and inspector
- When it applies a notice to inform parents of the existence of a communicable disease is posted on the front door
- All children's files have a profile and consent forms that are signed and dated by a parent/guardian
- The following administrative records are maintained on site: Financial records, daily attendance of children and staff, monthly emergency evacuation fire drills, smoke alarm, smoke detectors and fire extinguisher inspection and maintenance records
- Monthly emergency evacuation and fire drills are completed
- During the visit, it was observed that the operator is engaged with children at their level providing support and having conversations. Open-end questions are asked and guidance is provided in a respectful and calm way
- Children's indoor play area is safe and clean.
- Material and equipment proposed to children in the indoor play area are easily accessible on low, open shelves. It is varied and in sufficient quantity for all children present.
- Toxic products, and cleaning supplies are locked under key and are inaccessible to children
- Each child has an easily accessible space to store their personal belongings, which is labeled with their name and used only for the intended child.
- In the room, evidence of purposeful planning based on children's interest and learning, photos and learning stories were posted.

Observations: When arriving at the center, children were finishing their zoo phonics, they then transitioned into a short free play period and then ate their lunch. They all got ready and went outside to play.
