The Quality Assurance Monitor also observed that more than one incident (for multiple children) is on the same page. Incident logs must be kept confidential and must be individualized for each ch protect confidentiality, parents must not see the records of other children.

- -Child-to-staff ratio and supervision
- if required documents were posted in a visible and prominent place in the facility
- Incident records
- storage space for personal belongings

During the visit, one group of children went outdoors to play soccer while another group stayed inside for tabletop activities.

By the end of the visit, all groups transitioned to outdoor play.
